The new tours this year include the fun and memorable Motown Museum, the internationally famous Heidelberg project and the heart of Detroit's art scene the Russell Industrial Center where many local artists' work in a collection of mediums. These Detroit Artists were the topic of a Time magazine story discussing how innovative art can change a city.

All these events lead up to the grand opening of the 42nd Glass International Saturday evening.
