Saturday, May 4th:

A deluxe bus will pick up the VIP attendees at the Somerset Inn Hotel and travel to the Flint Institute of Art. Lunch will be served when we arrive and we will enjoy a talk by the director of the FIA, Tracee Glab. She will offer you a warm welcome and briefly discuss the museum's involvement in the glass arts. 
